


**Environment:** Young people living in remote, rural or sparsely populated communities

Barriers: Remote rural environments; alien concept to some; lack of knowledge and experience; differences in statutory provision

Model: Awareness campaigns; workshops; 1-1; country specific research; Enterprise Support Platform; tailored resources & support

Aim: To promote 'Starting a business' as a viable and realistic career option to young people in rural areas and progress more young people to 'young entrepreneurs' who thought innovatively when starting or growing a business.
